Current Status of OER in Management Institute Libraries in Mumbai

Abstract: This paper examines librarians' perspectives, awareness, and challenges related to creating awareness and promoting the use of open educational resources (OER) among faculty and students. Data were gathered from 15 ranked management institute libraries in Mumbai, according to NIRF and Times Bschools, and analysed using SPSS software.
